

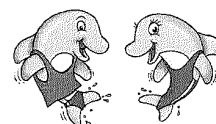
Phone the Longford Dental Clinic 6391 4206 to make an appointment
