

School Uniform Policy

Rationale

It is appropriate that as a school community we set standards of student dress which are socially acceptable and appropriate to specific learning situations. This applies to the participation in all aspects of school life.

Purposes

Uniforms:

- Help to make our students easily identifiable and as such help ensure the safety of our students due to ease of identification.
- Are also seen as being cost effective and do not distinguish between socio economic status.
- Are also seen as a way to foster connectedness.

Guidelines:

1. There is no legal compulsory requirement for students to wear school uniform, however, our community strongly encourages the wearing of the school uniform at Bracknell Primary.
2. No student will be denied access to schooling because of failure to wear the uniform.
3. Reasonable steps should be taken by the school to ensure that safety of students in relation to the sun (refer Sun Protection/Hat Policy)
4. School Uniform Policy is best formulated by the School Association and Parents & Friends Association and is as follows:

School Rugby Jumper – Maroon and gold stripe with school logo (purchased from school office).

School Jacket – Maroon and gold with school logo (purchased from school office).

Shoes – all students wear black school shoes or sandals.

Socks – all students wear black or white socks.

Summer Uniform

Girls – Students wear maroon shorts with gold polo tops and *school rugby jumper* and/ *school jacket* and *school approved hat*. Students may also wear the Bracknell Primary School summer dress (see school office).

Boys – Students wear maroon shorts with gold polo tops and *school rugby jumper* and/or *school jacket* and *school approved hat*.

Winter Uniform

Girls – Students wear maroon track pants with gold stripe with gold polo top (long or short sleeve) or gold skivvy and *school rugby jumper* and/or *school jacket*. Students may also wear the Bracknell Primary School winter skirt (see school office) with blue stockings. Boys – Students wear maroon track pants with gold stripe with gold polo top (long or short sleeve) or gold skivvy and *school rugby jumper* and/ *school jacket*. School shorts may be worn in winter.

Please note:

Maroon track pants with gold stripe, school rugby and school jacket are the preferred uniform however plain maroon track pants and jumpers are acceptable.

PE Lessons:

For weekly Physical Education (PE) lessons maroon and gold track pants or maroon shorts with gold polo, school rugby jumper or school jacket and sandshoes will be worn.

Sports Carnivals:

House colours are to be worn for our major sporting events - Swimming, Athletics and Cross Country.

Leonard House – Maroon polo top (only for carnivals) with maroon shorts. If you do not have a maroon top one will be provided by the school.

Preece House – Gold polo top with maroon shorts.

Conclusion - This policy will be revised in 2015.
